

Why did Disney Plus charge me \$150? Disney Plus High Charge Breakdown

Seeing a 1-866-927-4470 sudden **\$150 charge from Disney Plus** on your bank or credit card statement can be alarming, especially 1-866-927-4470 if you were expecting a small monthly fee.
