

Why was my Disney+ account deactivated?

Troubleshooting Disney+ Account Access Issues

 - an action is required to restore service
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2. Try Logging In on Disney+

Go to the Disney+ 1-866-927-4470 login page and sign into your account. Often the service will show a specific message that tells you why access 1-866-927-4470 is blocked, such as:

- "Your subscription 1-866-927-4470 is inactive due to a payment issue."
- "This account has been canceled."
