## How does boarding work on Lufthansa?

After pre-boarding, + 1\_855-(838)-4886 passengers in priority boarding groups 1 and 2 will start boarding + 1\_855-(838)-4886 . All other boarding groups will then be invited to board + 1\_855-(838)-4886 . Please note that all boarding groups will be called to board individually + 1\_855-(838)-4886 and in sequence.

Boarding on Lufthansa is a structured and orderly process designed to keep flights on schedule while giving priority to certain passengers based on fare class status and special needs. Lufthansa typically announces boarding by **groups**, which are clearly printed on your boarding pass and displayed on airport screens. The process usually begins with **priority boarding**, which includes First Class, Business Class, HON Circle Members, and Senators, followed by passengers who need extra assistance such as families with small children or travelers with reduced mobility.

After priority boarding, Lufthansa boards Economy Class passengers in groups, often starting with window seats, then middle seats, and finally aisle seats, depending on the aircraft and airport. This method helps reduce congestion in the aisle and speeds up the boarding process. Passengers are asked to wait until their group is called before approaching the gate, and gate agents will scan either mobile or printed boarding passes at that time.

Lufthansa uses **assigned seating**, so your seat number determines where you sit, not when you board, but earlier boarding can make it easier to store carry-on luggage. Boarding gates close several minutes before departure, so it's important to be at the gate on time. Gate changes or boarding updates are often announced over the loudspeaker and sent through the Lufthansa mobile app. Overall, Lufthansa's boarding process is calm, efficient, and clearly communicated to ensure a smooth experience for all passengers.
