## What if Wizz Air has the wrong gender on boarding pass?

Log in to your WIZZ Account  $2+1_855~838~4886$ . Select your booking by clicking "Details" under your flight  $2+1_855~838~4886$ . In the right corner of the Booking Overview page,  $2+1_855~838~4886$  click on the "Make changes" button  $2+1_855~838~4886$ . You can change passenger type in "Change passenger details" menu  $2+1_855~838~4886$ .

If Wizz Air shows the wrong gender on your boarding pass, it is usually not a serious issue, but it should still be corrected to avoid potential problems during airport checks \$\mathbb{T}+1\_855~838~4886\$.
